Resource Management

Become NIMS compliant and bring all resources, personnel and equipment, together into one database for more control and informed decision making.

The Resource Management module of the IC accomplishes three objectives.

1. On a daily basis, gain visibility and control over Resources stored across multiple jurisdictions.
2. Increase NIMS Compliance through classification of resource inventory according to the National Incident Management System (NIMS) Typing standards.
3. Order, Check In, Track, Monitor, and Demobilize Resources during an Emergency incident.
